

# INVITATION TO BID

**Project Name: Police Impound Project**  
**Project No. AB0601-CIP**

The City of Dublin, Ohio is seeking bids from contractors for a project known as the Police Impound Project, located at 6351 Shier Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio. This project consists of:

- Construction of a new steel storage building that will provide the City of Dublin Police Department with a controlled environment where forensic investigations can be implemented on impounded vehicles. The steel building will have a desired building footprint of 50' x 75' and will be constructed upon an existing asphalt area on the above referenced property.
- Storm sewer relocation and grading modifications to accommodate access to the new storage building.
- Construction of a vinyl perimeter security fence.
- Paving modifications.
- This project will be a design/build project whereby the eligible General Contractor must provide the City of Dublin with final building plans that will accommodate the manufactured steel building structure.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 27, 2010 at 6555 Shier Rings Road to review and discuss the project details. The meeting will be held at 1:30 pm (local time) and bidders will have an opportunity to walk the project site to review the proposed building location.

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes plainly marked CITY OF DUBLIN/STREETS AND UTILITIES – Project Name: POLICE IMPOUND PROJECT, and must be addressed to Ron Burns, Director of Streets and Utilities, City of Dublin, 6555 Shier Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016. Bids must be submitted no later than **1:30 p.m. (local time) on Wednesday, February 10, 2010** and will be publicly opened at that time at the address (Division of Streets and Utilities, 6555 Shier Rings Road) above. This is an Ohio Prevailing Wage Rate contract. The contractor and ALL subcontractors shall be required to submit Certified Payrolls.

A certified check, bank draft or a satisfactory bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the cost of said construction services shall be submitted with each bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bonds in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) each in the total amount of the bid.

Bid specifications and documents may be obtained or reviewed at 6555 Shier Rings Road, Dublin, Ohio 43016 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (local time), Monday through Friday, beginning **January 19, 2010**.
