Dear Civic/Homeowners Association Leader,

The Dublin community's 2010 Celebration of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. will take place on Monday, January 18, 2010. For the first time, Dublin will be launching the commemoration as a "Day of Service" to others. Janet Jackson, president and CEO of United Way of Central Ohio, will kick off the day of service at 11 a.m. at the Dublin Coffman High School Performing Arts Center, 6780 Coffman Road.

Following the celebration, guests will be invited to the commons area outside of the auditorium for light refreshments, where there will be attended stations for volunteer project sites. Project Site Leaders will register community members for assignments, distribute driving directions and give any other special instructions. Each site will host a volunteer project from 1:00 p.m. to approximately 4:00 p.m. that day. Volunteers under age 12 must have parental or adult volunteer supervision accompanying them. Pre-registration for service is also available by e-mailing cnardecchia@dublin.oh.us. Those who are not pre-registered may do so on-site at Dublin Coffman High School between 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m. that day prior to going to an outreach site.

The five project outreach sites include outreach to senior citizens in long term care facilities (indoor gardening, art projects) and outreach to those in need (warehouse organization and food prep/packing).
