

**PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE  
RECOMMENDATIONS OF 2-18-09**

**MOTIONS CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY:**

1. To continue with Spooktacular event in 2009. [Note: the Fall Harvest Jamboree is not a special event under Community Relations, but a Rec Services marketing program and budgeted in Rec Services. Therefore, brief discussion took place, but no recommendation was made regarding this item.]
2. To introduce the concept (“test the waters” to see what response is obtained in terms of more community involvement) of a community-organized Independence Day parade for the future  
Committee suggestions:
  - Do so through the April 1 civic association presidents meeting and to other community groups through outlets the City has;
  - Communicate the concept to the civic associations by means of a survey that they can circulate to their members in advance and they can then bring that input to the April 1<sup>st</sup> civic association presidents meeting;
  - Contact people in Upper Arlington for information about how they run their parade as a reference point
  - Consider asking people to serve on a task force to explore this concept
3. Regarding the Bicentennial, add a summer 2009 bed tax application deadline for Bicentennial-related applications; determine an allocation for funding (out of 2010 bed tax revenues) for Bicentennial-related applications; Finance Committee will review applications and make recommendations to Council for such grants. (Note: Council will continue to accept regular applications for bed tax grants in November of 2009, consistent with the established process.)
4. Community Relations to provide Council with an Independence Day event proposal for 2010 that would have a bicentennial celebration theme, carried out through a combination of City organized/City funded and community organized/community funded events for Independence Day weekend.
5. Community Relations role in the Bicentennial would involve an in-house “umbrella” campaign for the celebration in the following four areas: develop an online tool kit for any community group to use; support community initiatives with existing City tools; develop a community Bicentennial website; and host some community engagement meetings to foster communication among interested groups and individuals.
