

Traffic Calming Update from the Task Force

The Tara Hill Area Traffic Calming Task Force met on February 16.

We discussed the modifications we made to the Traffic Calming Concept Plan from the last meeting. We voted as a Task Force to move forward with this Concept. In our discussions, we considered other recommendations that could accompany the Plan, such as improvements at the perimeter of the Study Area.

We are encouraging all residents to attend the March 9 meeting to provide input on our Concept Plan. From this meeting, we will make any final adjustments before presenting a Recommended Plan to City Council.

Our next meeting topic was a mailing that will be sent out to the area residents prior to the March 9 meeting. We chose a letter and map to be provided to the Affected Area, and an invitation to be provided to the remainder of the Study Area.

We reviewed our public involvement and a status report memo that our chair, Randy Luikart, will give at the February 22 City Council meeting.
