

Traffic Calming Update from the Task Force

The Tara Hill Area Traffic Calming Task Force met on March 9. We appreciate the great resident turnout we had at the meeting. Thank you for taking the time to share your ideas.

The traffic consultants presented traffic calming background information and the Concept 10 traffic calming plan. Also discussed were other area road improvements that would encourage cut-through traffic to use Coffman Road, Brand Road, and Muirfield Drive. Comments from attending residents ranged from compliments to the Task Force for their efforts, concerns about diverting traffic onto other neighborhood streets, the size and location of the traffic calming measures, and endorsement of the traffic calming plan.

The Task Force reviewed an initial outline for the May 2 presentation to Council and discussed "Contact the Tara Hill Task Force" e-mails recently received.
