Who needs an ID?

You must be a **Dublin Resident** in order to purchase a daily pass or bring a guest to the pool. A valid photo ID with address must be presented to our Welcome Desk Staff. If your address has changed, a photo ID and a utility bill with your name and new address will be accepted.

Children coming to the pool without parents must also have a photo ID with address or a Resident ID Card (purchased at the Recreation Center for a nominal fee).

Unless accompanied by a Dublin Resident with ID, no one will be permitted to enter the park without proof of Dublin Residency or a Dublin Community Pool Season Pass.

Residency Policy

Clarification

Each year the City engages in a Cost Study of services where policies are reviewed and discussed to ensure the City's obligations to it's residents are met. The City certainly values the contributions and participation in activities from those residing outside of the city limits; however the facilities to support recreation services were designed to accommodate the residents within the city limits, not as a source of revenue or to market substantial usage from non-residents. Since they were designed with limitations, so too were the number of people they would serve. In order to ensure quality services continue to be offered to residents, certain limitations are necessary to avoid overcrowding and capacity issues that could require us to turn away the residents for whom the facilities were built.



Am I a Resident?

The City of Dublin, Dublin City Schools and Hilliard City School Districts are three separate entities with different budgets and funding sources. There are two school districts within Dublin city limits: Dublin City Schools and Hilliard City Schools. There are also Dublin School District residents who live outside Dublin city limits. As a result, your mailing address or school district is not always an accurate indication of your City of Dublin residency status.



We check your residency status by entering the address on your ID into our GIS (Geographic Information Services) mapping database. This database tells us whether or not you are a Dublin City resident.

Season Pass Holders

Season passes are available to Dublin Residents and Non-Residents (a limited number of passes are sold). Passes are sold at the Dublin Recreation Center.



All members must present their Membership Card to the pool welcome desk staff prior to entering the park. Members who do not have their cards may be asked to go to the Recreation Center to have a replacement card made.

Only City of Dublin residents may bring guests into the park.
