

## Southwest Tour

Blue Trail 

**Length:** 3.84 miles

**Terrain:** Flat; some streets to cross and follow

**Make sure to bring:** A flying disc (Frisbee)

This tour starts at the Woerner Temple Community Park (aka Ballantrae Park, 6350 Woerner Temple Road. There's plenty of parking!) Make sure to play in the spray park and get a close-up look at the leprechauns — but watch out, as they tend to have a mischievous sense of humor! Then, climb the hillock to get a close-up look at the 30-foot tall "Dancing Hares" sculpture. Can you find the scissors hidden in the hares' "fur?" What else can you find? The park also has restrooms and will be across the street from Dublin's newest community pool. Once you've explored the park, use the bike tunnel to cross Woerner Temple Road and visit Balgriffin Park at 5715 Norn Street, on the corner of Woerner Temple and Norn. Balgriffin Park has tennis and basketball courts, a playground, a drinking fountain and more! Next, head across Norn Street to the Disc Golf Course for a quick nine holes. Continue biking down Woerner Temple to Emerald Parkway. Head south, then turn west on Rings Road. Our fourth park on this tour is Trinity Park at 5719 Sandymount Drive, home of a playground, gazebo and basketball court. Use the bridge to visit the Commons at Brighton, 5750 Richgrove Lane. This park has beautiful European styling, a reflecting pool, a fountain, a specialty perennial garden and a playground. Cross the bridge again and bike west on Rings Road, through Dalmore Park. Then, turn north at Ballantrae Place, follow the circle, and head back through the tunnel to the start of the tour. Make sure to cool off in the spray park before heading home!
