## What to Bring to School's Out...

**LUNCH**—Please send a healthy, substantial lunch with your camper that DOES NOT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION. We do not provide refrigerators for camper lunches.

**WATER BOTTLE**—Please send a refillable water bottle with your camper. It is important to keep your camper hydrated and water does the best job.

**SWIMSUIT & TOWEL**—Please send a swimsuit, towel, and any other necessities (goggles, etc) that your camper needs to enjoy time in the pool.

**BACKPACK & BAG**—Please put all of your camper's things, plus any extras your child may need, (hat, extra socks, sweatshirt, etc) in **ONE BAG** that is clearly marked with your child's first and last name.

**HEALTH CARE FORM**—Please bring a completed Health Care Form for your camper. Campers are **NOT** permitted to be at camp if we do not have a completed form.

**APPROPRIATE PLAY CLOTHES**—We will be playing outside (weather permitting) so make sure to dress your camper in clothing that is comfortable for outdoor play.

**HOURS**—School's Out is open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.. Early drop-offs and late pick-ups will be charged an additional fee (see Parent Handbook).

**WHERE TO DROP-OFF & PICK-UP**—Drop-off and pick-up take place outside of the Arts & Crafts room upstairs OR outside of Classrooms A&B downstairs in the Recreation Center. All campers **MUST** be signed-in and -out by a parent/guardian.

## Inclement Weather Policy

School's Out will remain open unless the City of Dublin decides to cancel all programs being held on site at the DCRC. Typically, this would occur **ONLY** if the city streets are impassable.
