What to Bring to Spring Break Camp...

LUNCH—Please send a healthy, substantial lunch with your camper that DOES NOT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION. We do not provide refrigerators for camper lunches.

WATER BOTTLE—Please send a refillable water bottle with your camper. It is important to keep your camper hydrated and water does the best job.

SWIMSUIT & TOWEL—Please send a swimsuit, towel, and any other necessities (goggles, etc) that your camper needs to enjoy time in the pool.

APPROPRIATE PLAY CLOTHES—We will be playing outside (weather permitting) so make sure to dress your camper in clothing that is comfortable for outdoor play.

BACKPACK & BAG—Please put all of your camper's things, plus any extras your child may need, (hat, extra socks, sweatshirt, etc) in ONE BAG that is clearly marked with your child's first and last name.

HEALTH CARE FORM—Please complete Health Care Form ONLINE ONLY for your camper. Campers are NOT permitted to be at camp if we do not have a completed form.
