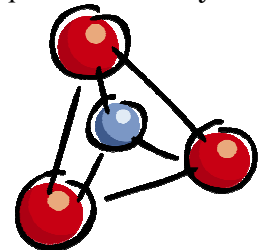
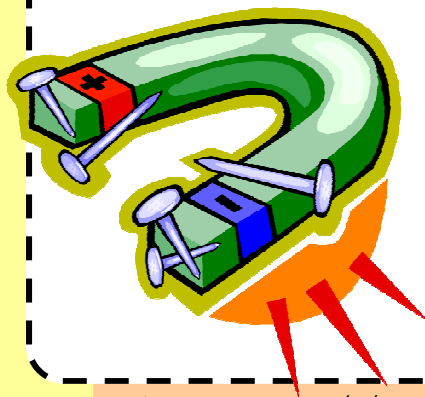

SWIMSUIT & TOWEL—Please send a swimsuit, towel, sunscreen and any other necessities (goggles, etc) that your camper needs to enjoy time in the pool.

APPROPRIATE PLAY CLOTHES & SHOES—We will be playing outside so make sure to dress your camper in clothing that is comfortable for outdoor play. Please send your camper in tennis shoes! Sandals, flip-flops, and Crocs are not appropriate for active play and put your camper at a higher risk for accident/injury.

BACKPACK & BAG—Please put all of your camper's things, plus any extras your child may need, (hat, extra socks, sweatshirt, etc) in ONE BAG that is clearly marked with your child's first and last name.

HEALTH CARE FORM—Please bring a completed Health Care Form for your camper. Campers are NOT permitted to be at camp if we do not have a completed form.
